



PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) statement

At Monitran Ltd, we are committed to ensuring the health, safety, and environmental responsibility of our products. We recognise the global concerns regarding per-and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which are subject to increasing regulatory scrutiny due to their persistence in the environment and potential health impacts.

According to European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are a large class of thousands of synthetic chemicals, considered as environmental pollutants and some that are linked to negative effects on human health.

United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provides a list of 189 PFAS in the Toxics Release Inventory (TRI).

European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) does not provide a specific PFAS restriction list, but a number of PFAS are on the REACH Candidate List of substances of very high concern (SVHC), for example, perfluorinated carboxylic acids (PFCAs), perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and perfluorohexane-1-sulphonic acid and its salts [PFHxS]

Monitran Ltd are continuing to work with suppliers to ensure that, to the best of its knowledge, its products do not include any PFAS, from EPA list or from the REACH SVHC list.
